## WELCOME

Exeter Cathedral is one of the finest cathedrals of England, and one of the finest examples of Gothic architecture anywhere.

Iconic and beautiful as it is, the Cathedral is not a museum. Though we are stewards of a significant part of the heritage of Exeter, we are most importantly a living community of faith, working to ensure that everyone who walks through the doors is inspired, engaged and moved by their experience.

At the heart of Cathedral life is the daily rhythm of worship, which is unbroken through the centuries, and continues into the future. This is described as the opus dei or 'the work of God' - not for its own sake but also in the way that it changes hearts and minds as well as providing space for inner sanctity, contemplation and prayer.

Liturgical music and the English choral tradition contribute greatly to the experience of worship in this place. The choral services are primarily sung in the course of the academic term by the Cathedral Choir which is formed of boy and girl choristers, and adult singers. The boy and girl choristers attend Exeter Cathedral School, which resides in the precincts of the Cathedral Close. At times when the Cathedral Choir is not singing, the services are led by the St Peter's Singers of Exeter Cathedral, the Cathedral Consort or by visiting choirs.

In these pages you will find details of the services from the start of the last half of the Trinity term until the end of term. Choral services are indicated in bold typeface.
