- The Cloister Gallery
- Reordering and extending the Pearson Cloister Building
- Re-roofing and reordering the former vestries to the south of the Quire

# Summary of the nature of work and its extent (and materials) [or in the case of an object, a short description of it and details of the proposal]

- Excavation of the foundations of the east cloister walk and construction of a Cloister Gallery linking the Cathedral to the Chapter House and Pearson Building.
- Construction of an extension to the northeast of the Pearson Building to house WCs including a fully accessible WC.
- Demolition of the vault and concrete roof over the former Vestries, construction of a new pitched roof over following the medieval roof line.
- Reordering the former Vestries and Cathedral Shop to provide WCs, an accessible WC, an adult changing spaces, space for the flower arrangers floor managers and storage.
- Local landscape improvements and drainage works.
- Installation of two ground water monitoring boreholes.
- Written scheme of archaeological investigations (WSI) and recording for the development/change works.
- Installation of two boreholes for ground water monitoring
- Reordering of the Pearson building including installation of a platform lift and associated works and a new means of escape from stairwell.
