TAKE NOTICE that the Chapter of the Cathedral Church of:

St Peter in Exeter

has on this date:

applied to the Fabric Advisory Committee of the said cathedral for approval of the following proposal:

FAC approval is sought for a programme of repairs to two monuments within the Cathedral:
Monument number 128 – Russell (Priority A) – Bay 13 Nave, North Aisle wall
Monument number 42 – Nutcombe, Nutcombe (Priority B) – South Quire Aisle

Summary of the nature of work and its extent (and materials) [or in the case of an object, a short description of it and details of the proposal]

For monument 128, a scaffold will be erected to allow access.
The monument will then be surveyed for metal, recorded, removed from the wall and ferrous metal removed and renewed in stainless steel.
Then a conservation clean and wax will take place before it is fixed back in place using the approved method.
This process will then be repeated for monument 42, with the exception of scaffolding.
