Summary of the nature of work and its extent (and materials) [or in the case of an object, a short description of it and details of the proposal]

The design revolves around a simple 100mm dia glass tube containing two conventional shaped LED bulbs which provide the general ambient light in the space. A metal band surrounds the central part of the glass tube to mask the lamp holders within. The band is finished to match the bronze-work of the shop display fittings and includes the same decorative brass finish quatrefoil design as other bespoke fittings in the wider cathedral scheme.
