### Section 8 of Care of Cathedrals Measure 2011 Public Notice on application to the Fabric Advisory Committee

#### PUBLIC NOTICE

**TAKE NOTICE that the Chapter of the Cathedral Church of:**

St Peter of Exeter

**has on this date:**

13<sup>th</sup> February

**applied to the Fabric Advisory Committee of the said cathedral for approval of the following proposal:**

To conserve, rotate, and illuminate the Drake window so that the stained-glass is presented and viewed from the Cloister Gallery, rather than the 'back-of-house' lobby.

#### **Summary of the nature of work and its extent (and materials)**

To the main lights:

- To carefully remove the three lights, pack, and transport to the studio / workshop.
- Install temporary glazing
- Prepare three careful rubbings from the lead matrix of the stained-glass panels for works, recording and appraisal and photographic record.
- Carefully dismantle the glass from the lead as necessary.
- For broken pieces employing the copper foil method, replace inappropriate repairs in glass to match to the original.
- For impact damage to the Drake panel carry out epoxy resin edge bond and infill repairs.
- For re lead panels in section closely matching the original in section and heart depth.
- To reinstate three lights, rotating the central light 180 degrees to be read from the west in the Cloister Gallery.

To the eyelits:

- To carefully remove the modern adhesive / sealant from the glass
- To carefully clean and conserve the glass in-situ

Within the lobby:

- To remove the single pendant bulb from the lobby and make good
- To install round surface mounted LED lights to the north and south walls of the lobby
