Approval is sought from the FAC for recovering of the lead roof to the old shop lobby, with improved detailing, and as associated structural timber repairs.

**Summary of the nature of work and its extent (and materials) [or in the case of an object, a short description of it and details of the proposal]**

It is proposed to lift and re-cover the lead roof, with adjusted detailing to make the lead connections less vulnerable to failure.

Repairs to the structural timber are proposed, where necessary.

A new suspended plasterboard ceiling is proposed to be installed, serving as a shallow service void for electrical cable distribution.

This will greatly improve the presentation of the lobby as it comes to serve the new visitor WCs.
