

### **Art Installation: From the Vow Made**

Sunday 1 June – Wednesday 4 June 2025, during Cathedral opening hours

A landmark sculptural installation featuring 1,000 wax objects made by 1,000 people in Devon, suspended from the Nave. Each of the 1,000 objects, or votives, will have been hand-crafted out of local Devon beeswax by a member of the local community, representing something for which each person is grateful.
